At this point, we assume all participants have reached Bielefeld, so congratulations on finding the city that doesn't exist¹!

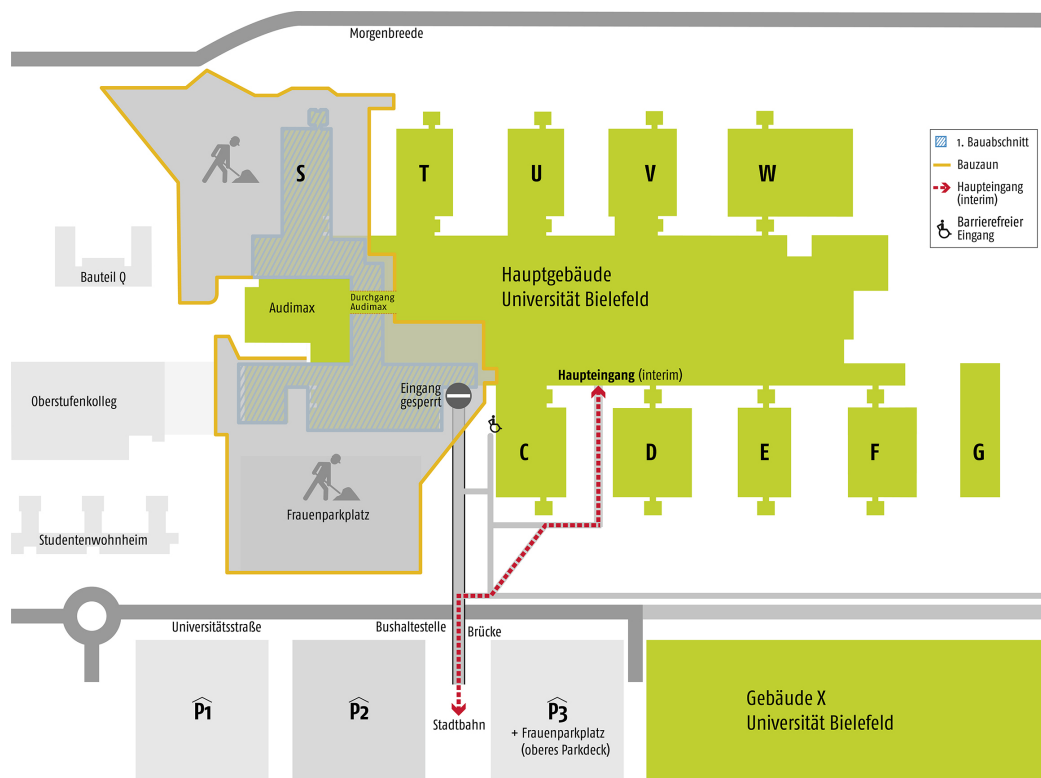
Accommodation details

Speakers and funded participants will stay at **Comfort Garni Hotel** (see <https://www.comfort-garni.de/>), conveniently situated within walking distance from Bielefeld's main train station.

How to get to the venue

You can reach Bielefeld University by taking **tram line 4**, direction **Lohmannshof**. For those accommodated in Comfort Garni Hotel, the nearest tram station is **Bielefeld Hbf**². Central tram stations are also **Rathaus** and **Jahnplatz**.
